Analysis

This legislation repeals the high school graduation requirement for passing a competency exam in reading, English, and mathematics.

The bill also requests the Department of Education & Early Development conduct an outreach effort to notify former students that they may request a high school diploma from their school district if they were otherwise qualified to receive a diploma, but did not because of failure to pass a portion or all of the HSGQE.

Notification of students who have not passed the HSGQE and received a certificate of achievement is estimated at \$8.0 (\$5000.00 for the design and 2 mail outs of student outreach materials for approximately 3,000 students). \$3000.00 for print ads in local newspapers throughout the state. This public awareness campaign would run through June 30, 2015.

The effective date of this legislation is immediate.

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
