FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2014 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This legislation would ban smoking on all State of Alaska airport property. The bill specifies no smoking at "airports" and does not distinguish between airport terminals and outdoor areas. Signage would be included at all 254 stateowned airports to notify anyone entering airport property that smoking is not allowed.
