 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
 * Section 1. AS 01.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:
 - Article 5. Laws of the United States.
- Sec. 01.10.200. Compliance with federal law. The state may not comply with a federal law, regulation, or presidential executive order until the appropriate branch or agency of the federal government provides to the applicable state agency, to the governor, and to the legislature a written description of
- 11 (1) how compliance with the federal law, regulation, or presidential 12 executive order will be accomplished; and
- 13 (2) the economic effect the federal law, regulation, or presidential 14 executive order will have on each community affected by the federal law, regulation,

1 or presidential executive order.
