**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1   **"An Act relating to a craft distillery license."**

2   **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3       \* **Section 1.** AS 04.11.080 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

4                               (23) craft distillery license.

5       \* **Sec. 2.** AS 04.11 is amended by adding a new section to read:

6                       **Sec. 04.11.175. Craft distillery license.** (a) A craft distillery license authorizes  
7           the holder to operate a distillery where alcoholic beverages are distilled and bottled or  
8           barreled for sale.

9                       (b) The holder of a craft distillery license may sell alcoholic beverages  
10          distilled and bottled or barreled on the premises in quantities of

11                       (1) not more than one gallon in a day to an individual present on the  
12          licensed premises for consumption off the licensed premises;

13                       (2) not more than five gallons in a day to a person licensed under this  
14          title or located in another state or country.

15                       (c) The holder of a craft distillery license may give a tour of the distillery

premises.

(d) The holder of a craft distillery license may permit a person to sample up to three ounces total a day of the alcoholic beverage or beverages distilled and bottled or barreled on the premises unless prohibited by AS 04.16.030.

(e) The biennial craft distillery license fee is \$500.

\* **Sec. 3.** AS 04.21.025(a) is amended to read:

(a) As a condition of issuance or renewal of a license and selling alcoholic beverages under a license, the board shall require a licensee who sells or serves alcoholic beverages and a licensee's agents and employees who sell or serve alcoholic beverages or check the identification of a patron to complete an alcohol server education course approved by the board, if the license is for a

(1) beverage dispensary;

(2) restaurant or eating place;

(3) club;

(4) package store;

(5) recreational site;

(6) pub;

(7) conditional contractor;

**(8) a craft distillery conducting activities under AS 04.11.175.**

\* **Sec. 4.** AS 04.21.065(a) is amended to read:

(a) A holder of one of the following types of licenses or permits shall post on the licensed or designated premises three separate warning signs as described in (b) of this section:

(1) beverage dispensary license;

(2) restaurant or eating place license;

(3) club license;

(4) brewery license; this paragraph applies only to a brewery that permits a person to sample portions of the brewery's product;

(5) package store license;

(6) common carrier dispensary license;

(7) recreational site license;

- 1 (8) pub license;
- 2 (9) winery license; this paragraph applies only to a winery that permits
- 3 a person to sample portions of the winery's product;
- 4 (10) caterer's permit;
- 5 (11) special events permit;
- 6 (12) conditional contractor's permit;
- 7 (13) another license or permit issued by the board authorizing
- 8 consumption of alcoholic beverages;
- 9 **(14) craft distillery license; this paragraph applies only to a craft**
- 10 **distillery that permits a person to sample portions of the craft distillery's**
- 11 **product.**
