### FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to distillery licenses."

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 04.11.170(b) is amended to read:

- (b) A distillery license authorizes the holder to sell alcoholic beverages [TO PERSONS LICENSED UNDER THIS CHAPTER] in
- (1) quantities of <u>not</u> more than <u>one gallon a day to a person who is</u>

  present on the licensed premises for consumption off the premises;
- (2) any amount to a person who is licensed under this title or in another state or country [FIVE GALLONS].
- \* Sec. 2. AS 04.11.170 is amended by adding new subsections to read:
  - (d) The holder of a distillery license may permit a person to sample small portions of the distillery's product free of charge unless prohibited by AS 04.16.030.
  - (e) Unless prohibited by AS 04.16.030, a holder of a distillery license may sell not more than three ounces a day of the distillery's product to a person for consumption on the premises if
