# A BILL

## FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to the selection by the Department of Health and Social Services of vendors under the federal Special Supplemental Food Program for Women, Infants, and Children."

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read:

WOMEN, INFANTS, AND CHILDREN PROGRAM PLAN AMENDMENT. The Department of Health and Social Services shall immediately apply to the United States Department of Agriculture for an amendment to the state plan for the Special Supplemental Food Program for Women, Infants, and Children under 42 U.S.C. 1786 to provide for a hardship exemption to vendor selection and approval criteria. The hardship exemption application must seek authorization to select and approve a vendor for participation in the Special Supplemental Food Program for Women, Infants, and Children if the vendor serves at least 35 recipients under the program who are of a specific nationality, ethnicity, religion, or

culture and are likely to encounter language, food selection, or other cultural barriers when purchasing from another vendor.
