FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2014 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB 189

Analysis

The bill amends AS 08.18.161(12) by clarifying that the terms and restrictions of the owner builder exemption from contractor licensing applies to an owner who performs all of the work independently and restricting an owner builder from advertising for sale or selling a building constructed under the exemption from contractor licensing requirements.

The department provides enforcement of this legislation, but there is no fiscal impact to the department anticipated as a result of this legislation.
