

"The CIRI Talkeetna Lodge is a 212 room Lodge operating the the tourism season. FNG provides LNG year round for heating, hot water and cooking. There is 10,000 gallons of LNG storage on-site for uninterrupted supply of natural gas. The Lodge receives a delivery of LNG approximately every two weeks."

AEA estimates (very rough) the cost of this equipment currently would be ~\$1,000,000 (2014)



SB 138 includes AEA energy planning


Section 69 of SB 138 directs the Alaska Energy Authority, in consultation with the Alaska Gasline Development Corporation, the Alaska Industrial Development Authority and the Department of Revenue to prepare a plan for developing infrastructure to deliver affordable energy to areas of the state that are not expected to have direct access to a North slope natural gas pipeline.
