Analysis

<u>Section 7</u> : Adds a new section 14.03.126 Funding for Internet services. A district in which one or more schools qualify for a discounted rate for Internet services is eligible to receive an amount for each school that is equal to the amount needed to bring the applicant's share to 10 megabits of download a second of the Internet services.
The following assumptions are provided as the basis for the fiscal note calculation: Starting in FY16, for all schools at less than 10 megabits, one-third of schools, EED worked with all internet services providers currently in the schools to generate an estimate of what their pricing would be in order to increase their school clients to the 10 megabit level with dedicated bandwidth. EED added the estimates for their annual charges for increased service and multiplied by .25, the average undiscounted portion for Alaska schools. The FY16 rate for those schools with less than 10 megabits will be \$7,308.0.
