Recommendation by Staff:

Staff recommends no additions or changes to the maintenance budget allocation for FY 16 as recommended by LAA. Note that FY 14 lapsed \$31,833. It is anticipated the FY 15 budget will lapse less funds: personal services contract expenses for former administrator, extra travel to Juneau for committee members and contract employee due to multiple ethics training classes for legislators and legislative employees as required by statute, and potential office and work space items to adapt to the new Anchorage LIO ethics office space.
