3 \*\* Sec. 5. AS 46.03.463(h) is amended to read:  
4 (h) The provisions of (a) - (f), and (i) of this section do not apply to  
5 discharges made for the purpose of securing the safety of the commercial passenger  
6 vessel or saving life at sea if all reasonable precautions have been taken for the  
7 purpose of preventing or minimizing the discharge.  
8 \* Sec. 6. AS 46.03.463 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:  
9 (i) Except as provided in (h) of this section or AS 46.03.462(c), a person may  
10 not discharge sewage, graywater, or other wastewater from a commercial passenger  
11 vessel into the marine waters of the state that has a copper concentration of more than  
12 two parts per billion for more than 10 minutes with a dilution factor not greater than  
13 50,000."
