Letter of Intent for CS For House Bill 32 (L&C)

It is the intent of CS FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 32(L&C), "An Act providing for the issuance of one business license for multiple trades, services, professions, or activities; and providing for reissuance of a business license to make a change on the license", that changes permitted under Section 3 of HB 32 would include the following types of changes that are not and could not be considered substantive changes to a license:

- Change of address
- Information erroneously placed in wrong part of a license application by the applicant
- Error in entry by applicant including spelling error, identification of trade, service, profession or activity

Types of changes that would be a substantive change in license or a change in business and not qualify for the change offered in Section 3 include:

- Change in the name of the business
- Change in the name or names of the business owner
