### Alaska Senior Population Projections

- 2015 estimated population of Alaskans age 60 and older is approximately 100,000.  
2024 estimated population of Alaskans age 60 and over is approximately 155,000.<sup>i</sup>
- 2015 estimated population of Alaskans with Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementia is approximately 7,000  
2025 estimated population of Alaskans with Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementia is 11,000<sup>ii</sup>

### Silver Alert Statistics

- Florida (Jan/Feb 2013) 23 alerts issued, 23 safe returns<sup>iii</sup>
- Georgia (2006-2009) 71 alerts issued, 70 safe returns.<sup>iv</sup>
- North Carolina (2012, 4<sup>th</sup> Qtr.) 66 alerts issued, 63 safe returns.<sup>v</sup>
- Texas (2007-March 31, 2012) 276 alerts issued, 251 safe returns.<sup>vi</sup>
