- 2015 estimated population of Alaskans age 60 and older is approximately 100,000. 2024 estimated population of Alaskans age 60 and over is approximately 155,000.
- 2015 estimated population of Alaskans with Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementia is approximately 7,000 2025 estimated population of Alaskans with Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementia is 11,000<sup>ii</sup>
