* Section 1. The following appropriation items are for operating expenditures from the
general fund or other funds as set out in section 2 of this Act to the agencies named for the
purposes expressed for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014,
unless otherwise indicated. A department-wide, agency-wide, or branch-wide unallocated
reduction set out in this section may be allocated among the appropriations made in this
section to that department, agency, or branch.

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* Sec. 6. PURPOSE. In accordance with AS 37.14.003 and 37.14.005, the appropriations made in this Act are for the state's integrated comprehensive mental health program.

- * Sec. 7. NONGENERAL FUND RECEIPTS. (a) Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority authorized receipts (AS 37.14.036) or administration receipts (AS 37.14.036) that exceed the amounts appropriated by this Act are appropriated conditioned upon compliance with the program review provisions of AS 37.07.080(h).
- (b) If Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority authorized receipts (AS 37.14.036) or administration receipts (AS 37.14.036) fall short of the estimates used as the basis of the appropriation, the affected appropriation is reduced by the amount of the shortfall in receipts.
- * Sec. 8. SALARY AND BENEFIT ADJUSTMENTS. (a) The appropriations made in sec. 1 of this Act include amounts for salary and benefit adjustments for public officials, officers, and employees of the executive branch, Alaska Court System employees, employees of the legislature, and legislators and to implement the terms for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, of the following collective bargaining agreements:
- (1) Alaska Vocational Technical Center Teachers' Association, National Education Association, representing employees of the Alaska Vocational Technical Center;
- (2) International Organization of Masters, Mates, and Pilots, for the masters, mates, and pilots unit;
- (3) Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific, Alaska Region, representing the unlicensed marine unit;
- (4) Marine Engineers' Beneficial Association, representing licensed engineers employed by the Alaska marine highway system;
- (5) Public Safety Employees Association, representing the regularly commissioned public safety officers unit;
 - (6) Public Employees Local 71, for the labor, trades and crafts unit;
 - (7) Teachers' Education Association of Mt. Edgecumbe;
- (8) Alaska Correctional Officers Association, representing correctional officers;
 - (9) Alaska Public Employees Association, for the supervisory unit;
 - (10) Alaska Public Employees Association, for the confidential unit;
 - (11) Alaska State Employees Association, for the general government unit.

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- (b) The operating budget appropriations made to the University of Alaska in sec. 1 of this Act include amounts for salary and benefit adjustments for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, for university employees who are not members of a collective bargaining unit and to implement the terms for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, of the following collective bargaining agreements:
 - (1) University of Alaska Federation of Teachers;
- (2) United Academics-American Association of University Professors, American Federation of Teachers;
 - (3) United Academics-Adjuncts;
 - (4) Fairbanks Firefighters Association, IAFF Local 1324.
- (c) If a collective bargaining agreement listed in (a) of this section is not ratified by the membership of the respective collective bargaining unit, the appropriations made in this Act that are applicable to the collective bargaining unit's agreement are reduced proportionately by the amount for that collective bargaining agreement, and the corresponding funding source amounts are reduced accordingly.
- (d) If a collective bargaining agreement listed in (b) of this section is not ratified by the membership of the respective collective bargaining unit and approved by the Board of Regents of the University of Alaska, the appropriations made in this Act that are applicable to the collective bargaining unit's agreement are reduced proportionately by the amount for the collective bargaining agreement, and the corresponding funding source amounts are reduced accordingly.
- (e) Appropriations made in sec. 1 of this Act for salary and benefit adjustments as described in (a) and (b) of this section are for the benefit of the state's integrated comprehensive mental health program only and do not necessarily affect every group of noncovered employees or every collective bargaining unit listed in (a) and (b) of this section.
- * Sec. 9. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES. The unexpended and unobligated balances, estimated to be \$3,873,200, of the appropriations made in sec. 5, ch. 34, SLA 2006, page 13, lines 15 16 (Department of Health and Social Services, cost share match for Bring the Kids Home \$5,000,000), sec. 4, ch. 29, SLA 2007, page 13, lines 15 17 (Department of Health and Social Services, MH cost share match for Bring the Kids Home \$1,000,000), and sec. 4, ch. 13, SLA 2009, page 14, lines 10 12 (Department of Health and

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Social Services, MH continuing Bring the Kids Home initiative Denali match - \$2,200,000) are reappropriated to the Department of Health and Social Services for the development of community-based support facilities providing transitional housing and training to high-risk, transition-age youth.

* Sec. 10. OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR. The amount necessary, estimated to be \$285,300, is appropriated to the Office of the Governor for distribution to state agencies to pay for a lump sum payment as negotiated in the collective bargaining agreement between the State and the Alaska State Employees Association, representing the general government unit, from the following fund sources:
