Analysis

The proposed legislation requires the Workforce Investment Board to facilitate the development and implementation of a statewide policy and procedure that provides for the acceptance of credit towards a degree or program offered by a vocational or technical center in the state of Alaska for a member of the nation's armed forces with relevant military education, training, or service. The Workforce Investment Board will conduct teleconferences between the state's applicable training center organizations as means of facilitating the development of a statewide policy and procedure.
