## **Analysis**

The bill makes changes to statutes to allow military education, service and training to act as an equivalent to some or all qualifications of certain license, certificate, postsecondary or technical programs. Individuals seeking such credit must provide satisfactory evidence of successful completion education, training or service as a member of the armed forces of the United States, the United States Reserves, or the National Guard, Military Reserves or Naval Militar of any state. Changes in statute relating to institutional authorization are required mandating institutions to accept military education, training or service credit hours toward a degree or technical program. There is not an anticipated fiscal impact relating to this bill.
