STATE OF ALASKA 2013 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. CSHB 71(FIN)

Analysis

HB 71 extends the termination date of the Alaska Regional Economic Assistance Program (ARDOR) from July 1, 2013 to July 1, 2016.		
Twenty-five years ago, the 15th Alaska State Legislature established the ARDOR Program and designated the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED) as its administrative agency. The ARDOR Program has been reauthorized by the Alaska State Legislature approximately every five years since 1988. Without reauthorization during the 2013 Legislative Session, the program is scheduled to sunset June 30, 2013.		
The Department awards 807.6 in grants to 13 ARDORs. The remaining 51.9 in personal services pays for a portion of DCCED staff time associated with administering the grants and the ARDOR program in general. This funding is included in the Governor's proposed FY2014 budget.
