• Has the elder abuse law the legislature passed recently made a noticeable impact and if so what is the impact?

Yes it has had a positive impact. Adult Protective Services has been able to deal with more financial issues – and we are using the subpoena powers in some cases. I can gather anecdotal case information from the APS attorneys if you want but the long and short of it is yes, it has improved our practice in protecting vulnerable adults, especially with respect to financial exploitation.
