DOT&PF's Airport Police & Fire Officer (APFO) units (at Anchorage Intl and Fairbanks Intl only) are registered fire departments under the state, with liability coverage. Additionally, our rural aircraft rescue and firefighting (ARFF) personne are Maintenance & Operations folks trained in firefighting skills and, to the best of our knowledge, have mutual aid agreements with every community in which they are located, i.e., in the certificated Part 139 airports – the hubs. They do respond to local situations, as they are on the state time clock to ensure continued state coverage for those situations. <i>However</i> , those personnel are NOT registered fire departments like the international airports are.
