





Prison Population Up 27% in Last Decade



Prison Population is Half Sentenced Offenders, Half Supervision Violators and Pretrial Defendants




Largest Growth Among Pretrial Inmates




Pretrial Defendants Make Up 28% of Alaska's Prison Population


Prison Population on July 1, 2014, by Status




Number of Pretrial Defendants Up 81% in Last Decade




Pretrial Admissions Down 13%, But Still High Numbers of Nonviolent Misdemeanor Admissions




Average Pretrial Length of Stay Up




Sentenced Offenders Make Up 50% of Alaska's Prison Population



Number of Sentenced Inmates Up 14% in Last Decade




Despite Declines, 82% of Prison Admissions Are Misdemeanants

Mean Length of Stay for Sentenced Offenders Convicted of Nonviolent Felony Charges, 2005 and 2014, by Offense Category




Felony Length of Stay up 17% for Person Offenders; 86% for Sex Offenders





Supervision Violators Make Up 22% of Alaska's Prison Population





Number of Supervision Violators Up 15% in Last Decade





Nearly Half Of Revocations Staying More Than One Month; 29% More Than Three Months




Recidivism

Projected Growth and Costs


Spending on Corrections Up 60% Over Past 2 Decades
