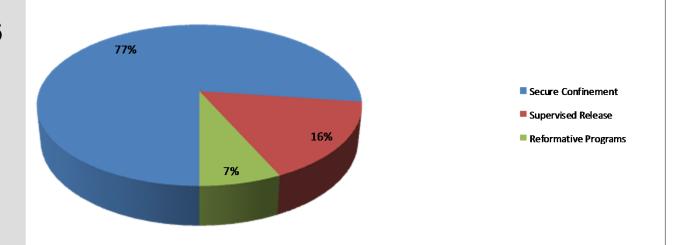

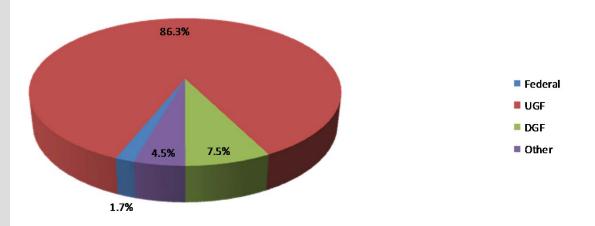

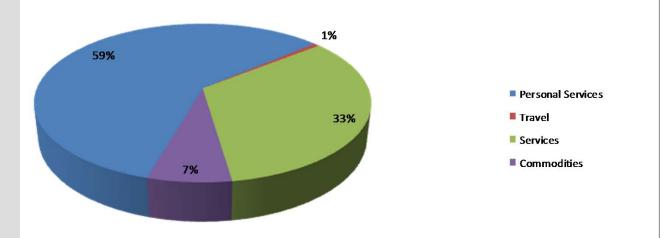

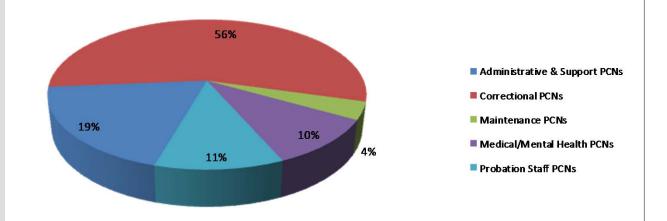

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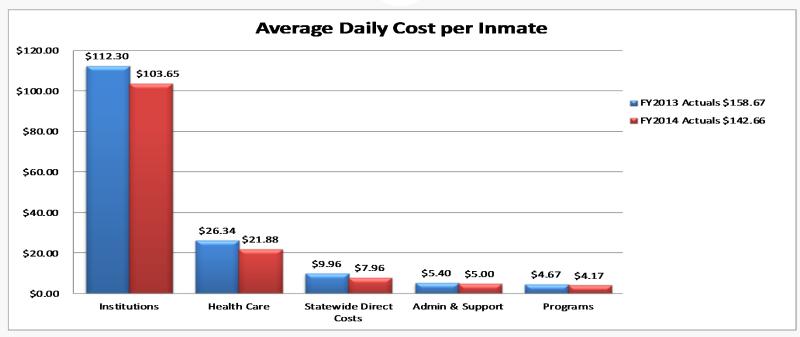
Fiscal Year 2016 Operating Position Allocations

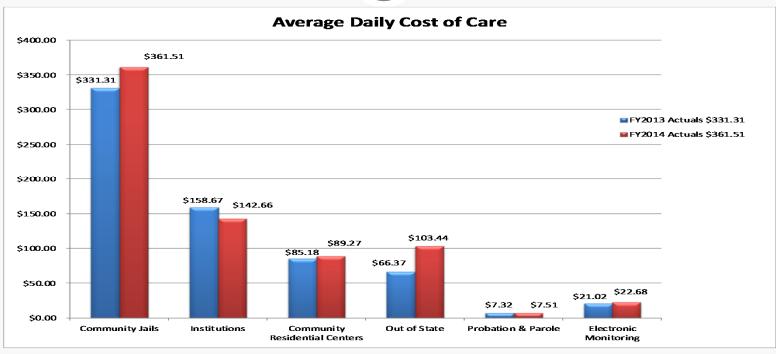

- The delivery of reformative programs is highly efficient.

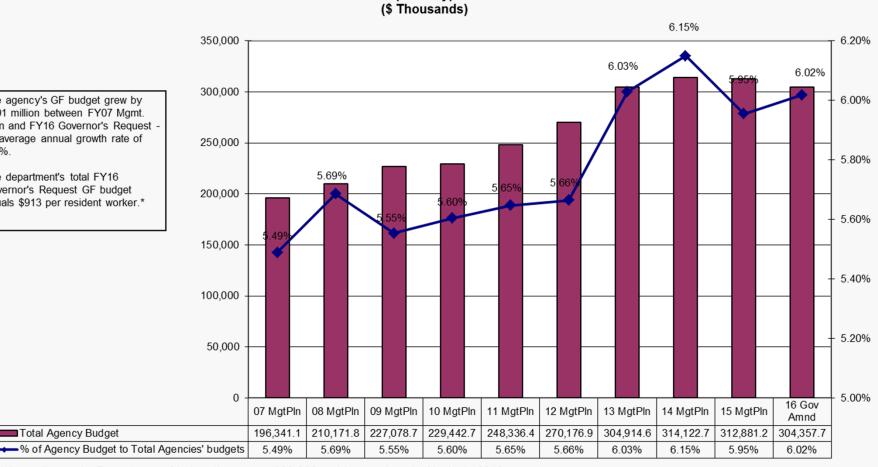
Department of Corrections FY2016 GF % of all Agencies

The agency's GF budget grew by \$101 million between FY07 Mgmt. Plan and FY16 Governor's Request an average annual growth rate of 5.0%.

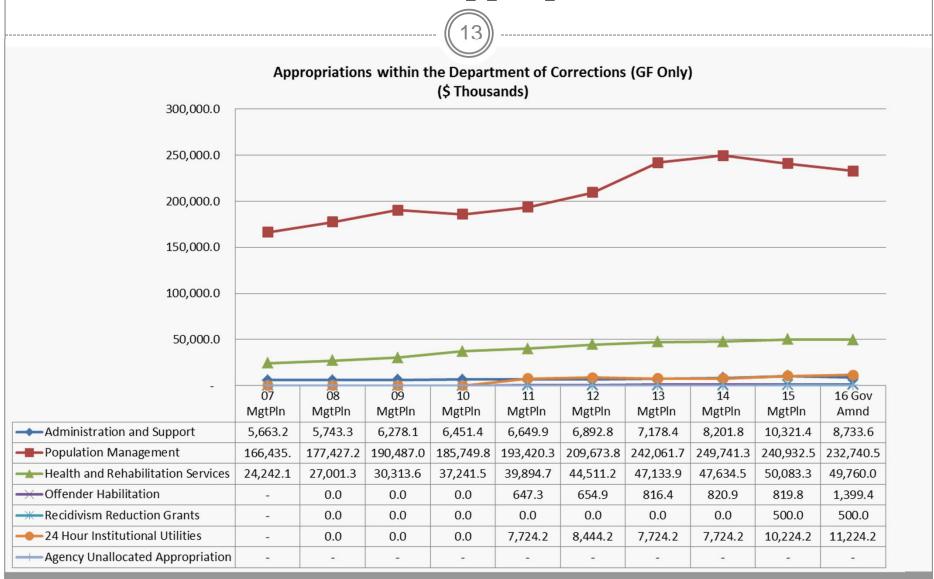
The department's total FY16 Governor's Request GF budget equals \$913 per resident worker.*

Total Agency Budget



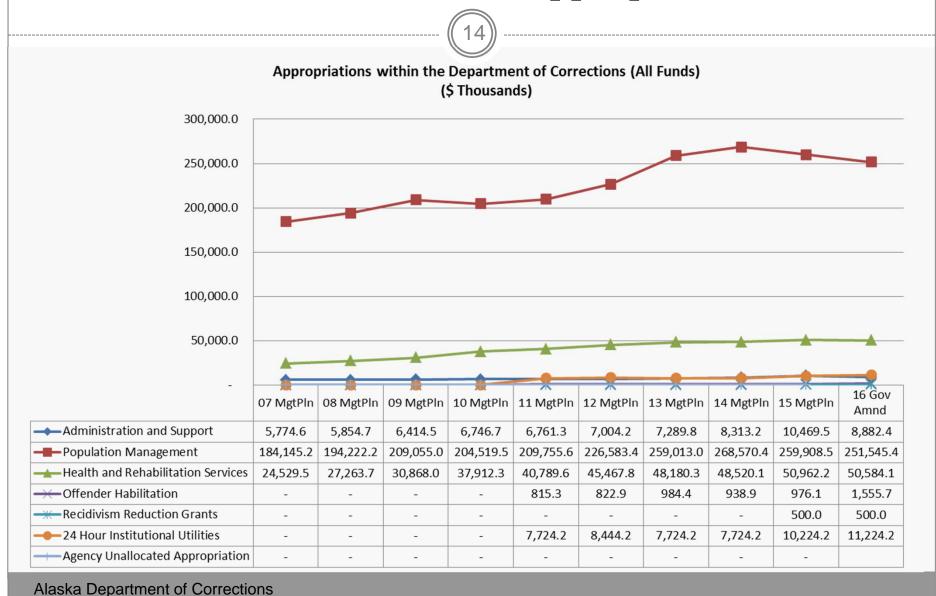
