#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* **Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

#### Article 5. Standard Time.

**Sec. 44.12.400.** Exemption from daylight saving time. The state exempts itself from observation of advanced time, also known as daylight saving time, during the period set under 15 U.S.C. 260a for the advancement of time each calendar year, and the entire state shall observe the standard time that is otherwise applicable during that period.

\* Sec. 2. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read:

1 TO CHANGE THE TIME ZONE IN WHICH ALASKA IS LOCATED. The legislature, by 2 this Act, petitions the United States Department of Transportation to initiate proceedings 3 under the Uniform Time Act of 1966 to hold hearings in the appropriate locations in Alaska 4 on the issue of changing the boundaries of the time zones in which Alaska is located or 5 placing all or part of the state within the Pacific standard time zone as provided in the United States Department of Transportation's "Procedure for Moving an Area from One Time Zone 6 7 to Another." Within 21 days after the effective date of this section, the governor shall send a 8 copy of this Act along with any other necessary documentation prescribed by the United 9 States Department of Transportation to the appropriate official of the United States 10 Department of Transportation.
