Analysis

Analysis/Assumptions:
SB111 amends AS 18.31 by adding new sections that will prohibit the manufacture, sale, or distribution of upholstered furniture or children's items that contain 100 or more parts per million of a variety of flame retardants effective July 1, 2017. It also requires manufacturers to label these items with the following statement: "This product contains a chemical flame retardant." The legislation also establishes a civil penalty schedule, and adds various definitions to statute, including "children's item."
As written, the bill has no fiscal impact to the Department of Environmental Conservation.
