






### Look-Back with Funding Source Changes


Department of Military & Veterans Affairs' Share of Total Agency Operations (GF Only) (\$ Thousands)


The Department's total FY17 Governor's Request GF budget equals \$56 per resident worker.\*

■Total Agency Budget










### **Budgeted Positions Look-Back**








#### All Funds Look-Back



–DGF decreased by \$620.1 (-96%)


–Other funds decreased by \$17.5 million (-52%)


