"An Act relating to a voluntary preference for veterans by private employers."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 18.80.200 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
 - (c) Nothing in this chapter is intended to prohibit a private employer from granting an employment preference to a veteran when hiring an employee. In this subsection, "veteran" means a person who was honorably discharged from service in
 - (1) the armed forces of the United States;
 - (2) a reserve unit of the armed forces of the United States;
 - (3) the Alaska Territorial Guard;
 - (4) the Alaska Army National Guard;
 - (5) the Alaska Air National Guard; or
 - (6) the Alaska Naval Militia.
- * Sec. 2. AS 23 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

Chapter 55. Employment of Veterans.

Sec. 23.55.010. Veteran hiring preference allowed. A private employer may
