Mission

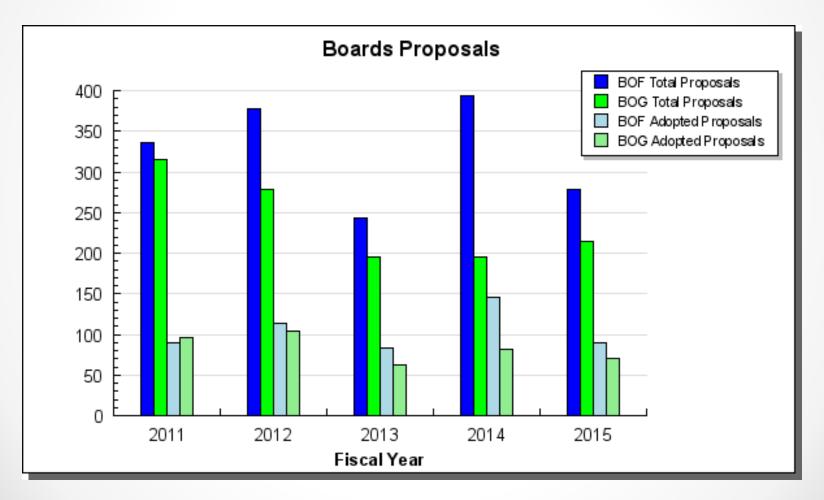
The Boards Support Section facilitates an effective board and public process for the state's fish and wildlife regulatory system.

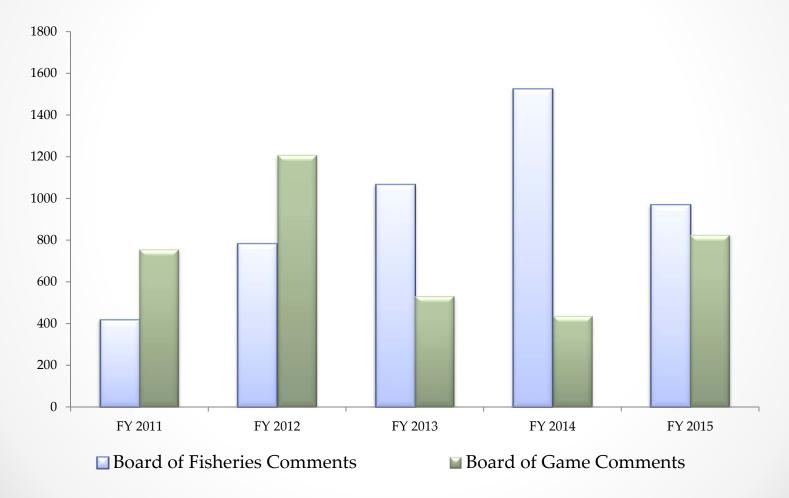

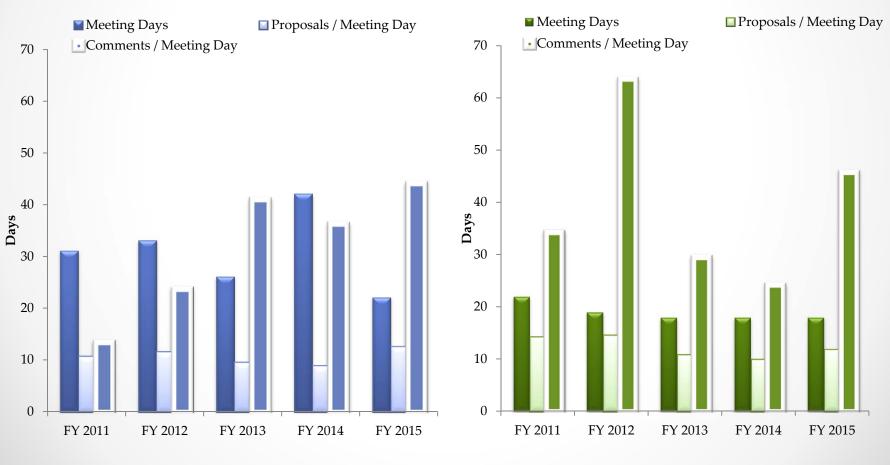

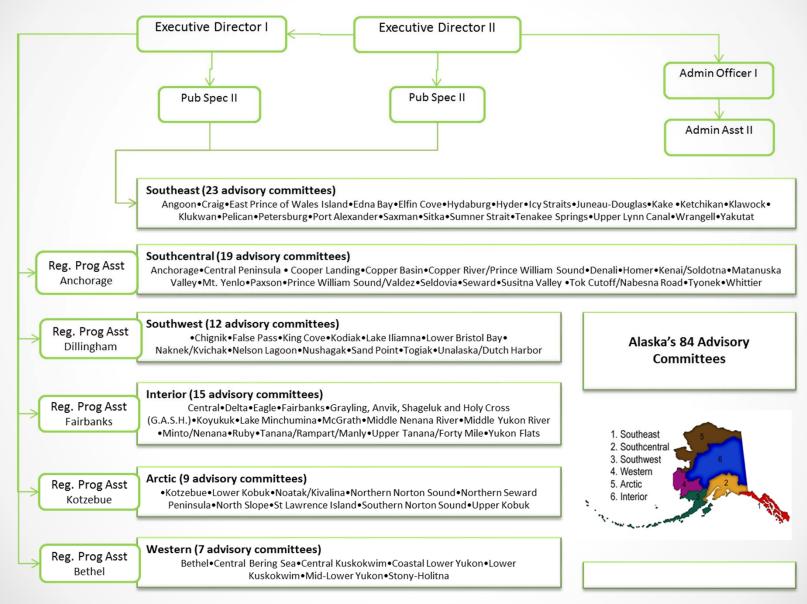

Boards Support Section - Organizational Chart

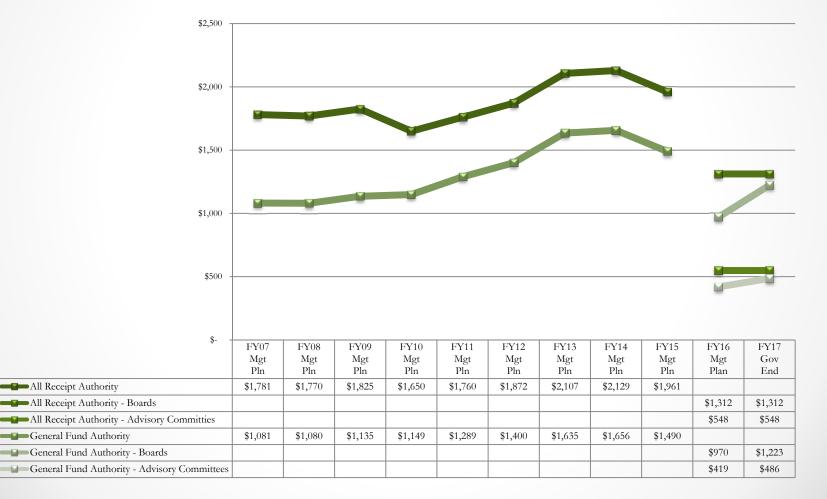
