1 Page 8, following line 16:

2 Insert a new subsection to read:

3 "(e) Notwithstanding (a) - (c) of this section and in addition to the projects and  
4 services described under (d) of this section, the department shall apply for a section  
5 1115 waiver under 42 U.S.C. 1315(a) to establish one or more demonstration projects  
6 focused on innovative payment models for one or more groups of medical assistance  
7 recipients in one or more specific geographic areas. The demonstration project or  
8 projects must include a managed care system that operates within a fixed budget to  
9 reduce medical cost inflation, improves the quality of health care for recipients, and  
10 creates a healthier population. The department shall design the managed care system  
11 to reduce the growth in medical assistance expenditures with a goal of reducing the  
12 per capita growth rate for medical assistance expenditures by at least two percentage  
13 points. The demonstration project or projects may include

- 14 (1) managed care organizations as described under 42 U.S.C. 1396u-2;  
15 (2) community care organizations;  
16 (3) patient-centered medical homes as described under 42 U.S.C. 256a-  
17 1; or  
18 (4) other innovative payment models that ensure access to health care  
19 without reducing the quality of care."
