The ARDOR program was created in 1988, with the goal of supporting regional economic development organization's efforts to grow and strengthen their local economies. The 11 organizations that currently hold ARDOR status work diligently to uphold that mission. Leveraging a relatively modest investment by the state (roughly \$70,000 per ARDOR), these organizations have been able to match the state funds they receive by almost three to one. They have then utilized this funding to do a range of important projects across the state which have improved the local economies and driven economic development efforts statewide.

Aniak Traditional Council is proud to support the ARDORs efforts to make Alaska a better place to live, work, and play. We believe that this type of statewide, collaborative economic development effort is exactly what Alaska needs at this time.
