## **Analysis**

HB 162 removes the department's authority to impose an Administrative License Revocation (ALR) on an individual's driver license. The authority to revoke driving privileges for DUI would lie solely with the court system.
Fiscal impact to State of Alaska While there is no fiscal impact to the department, it must be noted that federal funding opportunities could be compromised. Because drunk drivers are a danger to the public and the state, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) encourages states to require prompt and mandatory revocation of a driver's license for DUI and Refusal. ALR is tied to federal grant incentives to encourage states to adopt these laws, which were adopted in Alaska in 1983.
