**WHEREAS** the majority of the state's population, along with the majority of legislators and staff, resides along the road system;

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Alaska State Legislature supports a location for a special session of the Twenty-Ninth Alaska State Legislature, if called after adjournment of the Second Regular Session of the Twenty-Ninth Alaska State Legislature, that is the least costly and most accessible location; and be it
