Analysis

This legislation would ban smoking in enclosed areas at all 247 State of Alaska rural airports including state-owned airport terminals, fuel facilities, and other enclosed areas in a place of employment (sand storage sheds, equipment storage/maintenance facilities, airport rescue/firefighting facilities). Lines 27 and 28 of page 4 require the Dept of Health & Social Services to furnish any new signs the Department might need in the future at no cost to the Department.
