4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- **Section 1.** AS 08.88.396(e) is amended to read:
- 6 (e) In a civil action <u>arising out of</u> [FOR] the failure of a licensee to comply
- with the provisions of this section, the plaintiff's remedy is limited to the recovery of
- 8 actual damages. This subsection does not limit a person's ability to take any other
- 9 action or pursue any other remedy to which the person may be entitled under other law
- 10 <u>except for a claim arising out of a violation of this section.</u>

- APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to a real estate transaction that occurred on or
- before the effective date of this Act and to an action pending on the effective date of this Act

- 1 in a court in the state relating to a transaction that occurred on or before the effective date of
- 2 this Act in which a final judgment has not been rendered before the effective date of this Act.
- 3 In this section, "real estate transaction" has the meaning given in AS 08.88.990.

- 6 RETROACTIVITY. Section 1 of this Act is retroactive to January 1, 1991.
