Dear Commissioner,

I would like to apply for the South Central/Labor seat on the Workers Compensation Board. I believe I bring a unique skill set to the Board as I am both a Registered Nurse and representative of Union members employed in the healthcare field.

Healthcare workers are subject to high rates of job related musculoskeletal injuries. I see the effects of those injuries almost daily. I have lost count of the times I have heard an injured member say "I just want to get back to work." I have seen the frustration on management's side as they struggle to find light duty assignments and handle the paperwork required in processing a claim. My role has evolved into acting as a bridge for the worker; helping them to understand their responsibilities as well as their rights under workers compensation. Being on the Board seems like a natural extension of much of what I already do.

As a union representative I have a large amount of experience working in labor-management settings. Being able to compromise and resolve competing interests are essential. Working with groups that do not see eye to eye, formulating agreements that satisfy both groups, while maintaining the duty of fair representation is a challenge I thrive on.


I look forward to the opportunity to serve on the Board and thank you for your consideration.
