BILL NO. HB282

Analysis

HB 282 adds one nonvoting member who is a member of the House of Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the House and one nonvoting member who is a member of the Senate, appointed by the President of the Senate to the Alaska Gasline Development Corporation Board of Directors.

The board meets at the call of the chair, at least once every three months.

A minimal travel budget is incorporated into this fiscal note to cover legislative members travel to the meetings.
