Analysis

DNR anticipates that there will be no fiscal impact to the department from this legislation.					
Section 1 of the bill proposes to enact AS 38.40.375 to name the shooting range located near Mud Lake on Maude Road within the Knik River Public use Area the Kenny and Patti Barber Shooting Range.					
Section 2 of the bill proposes to amend the uncodified law of the State of Alaska by adding a new subsection that would prohibit the state from replacing a state-owned sign identifying the shooting range unless the existing sign is damaged or due for replacement according to regularly scheduled maintenance.
