Good Afternoon Senators Stoltze & Dunleavy,

I provided testimony this morning on CSSB89, Section 3, relating to the proposed requirement for active parental permission for students to participate in any questionnaire or survey. The Association of Alaska School Boards has created a survey, School Climate and Connectedness Survey (SCCS), to permit schools to determine if there are destructive behaviors that can be improved to enhance school safety. The value in the survey is the large numbers of students who participate. We believe getting parental permission would deter schools participation because of the burden of getting these permissions. Our intent is not to intrude on student and family rights but rather through an anonymous survey understand what can be done to ensure student success both in and out of school. The committee requested a sample of the types of questions asked on the survey. I am including a copy of both the grades 3-4 and 5-12 surveys. Thanks for your interest. 
