Subject: Legislative Review of Detachment from and Concurrent Annexation to the City  
of Allakaket

Dear President Meyer:

The Local Boundary Commission ("commission" or "LBC") presents to the First Session of the Twenty-Ninth Alaska State Legislature the commission's decision to approve the detachment of 174 acres from and the concurrent annexation of 12.3 square miles of territory to the City of Allakaket ("City"). This presentation is done pursuant to article X, section 12, of Alaska's constitution. Under article X, section 12, the commission "may present proposed changes to the legislature during the first ten days of any regular session. The change shall become effective forty-five days after presentation or at the end of the session, whichever is earlier, unless disapproved by a resolution concurred in by a majority of the members of each house."

In 2013 the City of Allakaket had petitioned to detach 174 acres of land important to the Alakna community, and concurrently annex 12.3 square miles of land and water. Allakaket residents had moved to higher ground outside of city limits after the 1994 flood and wished to be included in the city again.

On October 14, 2014, the LBC held a duly noticed public hearing in Allakaket regarding the petition. At the hearing the commission heard sworn testimony from several witnesses for the city. The commission also heard comments from public members favoring the proposed boundary changes. No comments were made against the proposed boundary changes. After careful review, the commission voted 5 to 0 to approve the detachment and concurrent annexation petition.
