### Analysis

This bill will allow for the disposal of land within three legislatively designated areas: Denali State Park, Captain Cook State Recreation Area and Willow Creek State Recreation Area. The disposal of land within the three areas would occur according to AS 38.35 and only for the purpose of leasing land to build and operate a natural gas pipeline from the North Slope. The state would retain the right to provide public access on that portion of park lands that are subject to a lease. Recreational, scenic, cultural, historical and habitat values of lands leased would be preserved to the maximum extent practicable. A lease authorized under this legislation would have to be in place by January 1, 2025. In addition, pipeline construction would be required to occur within 10 years of the effective date of the lease.
