STATE OF ALASKA 2015 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This bill adds definitions for "domestic partner" and "veteran" in Alaska Statutes 18 and 23. This bill allows private employers to grant an employment preference to a veteran, or to a spouse or domestic partner of a veteran, when hiring an employee.
