


The Civics Education Initiative is sponsored by the Civics Proficiency Institute, an affiliate of the Joe Foss Institute. The goal is to pass legislation in all 50 states by September 17, 2017 - the 230th anniversary of the U.S. Constitution. As of January, 2016 nine states (AZ, ND, SD, UT, ID, TN, SC, LA, WI) have passed CEI legislation.





U.S. Citizenship Civics Test - Of course you can pass. Right?

Immigrants applying for U.S. citizenship have to pass a civics test asking basic questions about American history and government, and approximately 93 percent succeed. But, only 65 percent of native-born Americans could answer correctly when asked the same questions.

The Civics Education Initiative, sponsored by the Joe Foss Institute, requires high school students to pass the test as a requirement for graduation. This sets the very basic standard for civic knowledge.


