FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. HB 48

Analysis

HB 48 extends the statutory authority for the existing Board of Registration for Architects, Engineers, and Land Surveyors through June 30, 2025. Adoption of the bill will continue existing activities by the board and administrating by the division. Failure to adopt the bill will result in a one-year wind-down of the board in FY2018, and the division would assume all licensing responsibility in FY2019.

In addition to extension of the Board, this legislation proposes to add one (1) landscape architect board member.

If the bill passes the following expenses will be incurred:

Travel:	\$6.0 (one new board member to attend four board meetings per year, requested in first year)
	\$27.8 (one staff and ten board members to attend four board meetings per year, included in Governor's FY2018 request)
	\$33.8 (one staff and eleven board members to attend four board meetings per year, in out years)
Services:	\$0.2 (advertising of public notice of board meetings)
	\$1.0 (training/conference fees for board members)
	\$0.5 (honorarium/stipend for board meetings)
	\$0.1 (commission sales for booking board member travel)

Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by Receipt Supported Services, fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF). Licensing fees for each occupation are set per AS 08.01.065 so the total amount of revenue collected approximately equals the occupation's actual regulatory costs.
