- 2015-2016 Guide/business registration/fresh and saltwater logbook
- 2017 HB41 Saltwater license/freshwater registration/fresh and saltwater logbook

Saltwater License Requirements

Saltwater guides:

- Citizen of US, Canada, or Mexico, or resident alien
- 1st Aid certification
- Current Alaska sport fishing license
- \$100 fee

Saltwater businesses:

- Current Alaska business license
- General liability insurance-\$100K per incident/\$300K per year
- \$200 fee
- If guiding, must comply with guide requirements

Freshwater Registration Requirements

- Freshwater guides:
 - Validated freshwater sport fishing guide registration form
 - Valid Alaska sport fishing license
- Freshwater businesses:
 - Validated freshwater sport fishing guide business registration form

Logbooks

- Fresh and salt water sport fishing guides must obtain and complete a logbook if operating in Alaska fresh or salt waters
- Includes vessel registration
- Collects location where sport fishing services were provided, effort, catch, and harvest of sport fish by clients, owners, or employees
- Must be completed at the end of the fishing trip and returned weekly to the department

Value of Logbook Data

- Comprehensive fresh and salt water sport fish guide data
- Official data source for charter halibut harvest
- Harvest, catch, and participation trends
- Data used in Board of Fisheries process
- Verification of Statewide Harvest Survey and creel surveys
- eLogBooks implemented in freshwater in 2017, saltwater in 2018






Sport Fishing Guides/Businesses




Freshwater Guide/Businesses by Region
