Some of the 300 different permit types available to fishermen.

CFEC permits are organized first by the species of fish or shellfish, also by the area of the state, gear type, and by the allowable size of the fishing vessel

Permits are issued to <u>persons</u>, not vessels (just skippers need a permit)

There are 2 broad categories of CFEC permits:

1) Limited entry permits for the 80 fisheries which have been found necessary for limiting participation (example Bristol Bay salmon drift)

Category 2. of CFEC permits:

Interim-use permits which are for open access fisheries, NOT LIMITED and available to all comers on an annual basis (example Halibut with a longline vessel less than 60 feet)

MOST of all permits issued are for limited entry fisheries like Bristol Bay salmon; all of them occur in state waters (approx 14,000 for 2017)

FEWER of all permits issued are interim-use permits for open access fisheries, including those in Federal waters (approx 3,700 for 2017)

Many fisheries occur in Federal waters outside of Alaska's 3-mile limit; nevertheless a CFEC interimuse permit is necessary to participate (Halibut is a prime example)

Even though there are more limited entry permits issued, the total of earnings from them in 2015

\$480 million

far LESS than the \$1.34 BILLION from interimuse permits

This pie chart is the 17,729 permits estimated to be issued for 2017

The most 'popular' limited entry permit-Bristol Bay salmon drift 10% of all permits CFEC will issue in 2017

The most 'popular' interim-use permit– Statewide halibut longline vessel less than 60 feet also 10% of all permits for 2017

The 15 permit types capped by the fee ceiling-3% of all permits for 2017

FEES for permits are always 4/10 of 1% of the market value of Limited Entry permits

This pie chart is the \$1.82 BILLION exvessel earnings made at the dockside by fishermen in 2015 (the most recent data available)

2015 earnings made with the BB drift permit: \$105 million

2015 earnings made with the halibut permit: \$88 million

In 2017, CFEC will issue approx 485 of the permits capped by the fee ceiling; those permits were used to make: \$1.03 BILLION in 2015

Those permits had a fee of \$3000, which represented % as low as: 1/10 of 1% of earnings

The complexion of CFEC permits in general is mostly Alaska residents

Permits capped by the fee ceiling will be mostly non-residents

With the current fee ceiling , there is an estimated \$2.2 million which could have been collected for 2017 (foregone revenue to the state).

90% of that foregone revenue would be collected from non-residents
