Memo of Changes for HB 2

The Military and Veterans Affairs Committee adopted the following changes:

- Expanded the private employer preference to allow for active National Guard members as well.
- Replaced "honorably discharged" to "discharged under honorable conditions" on page 1, line 6 and page 2, line 2. This change was made to include service members who are released under a general discharge.
- Updated AS 39.25.159(f)(3) to remove the requirement that National Guard members serve at least eight years before they qualify for the public employer preference.
