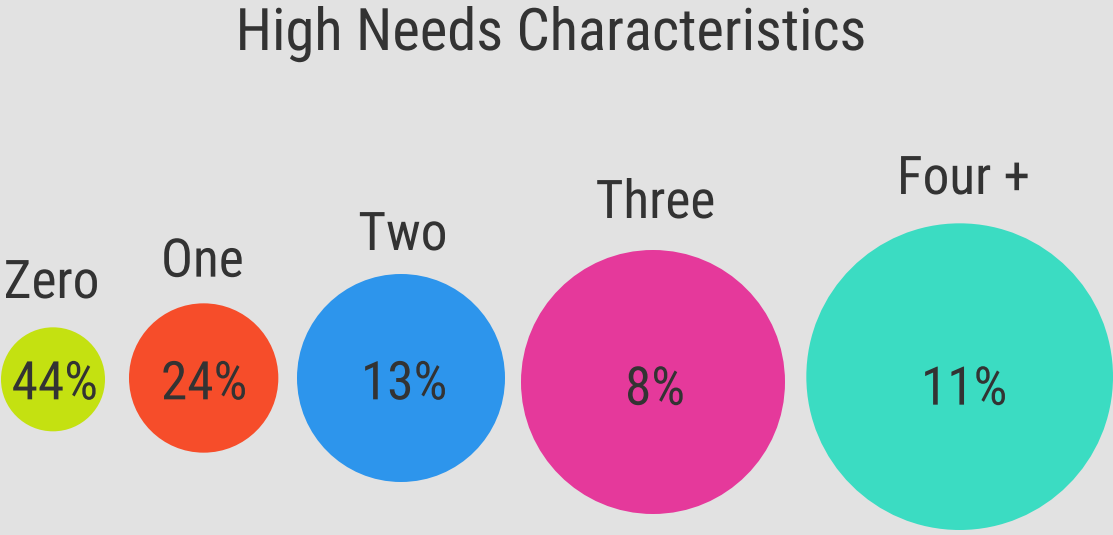
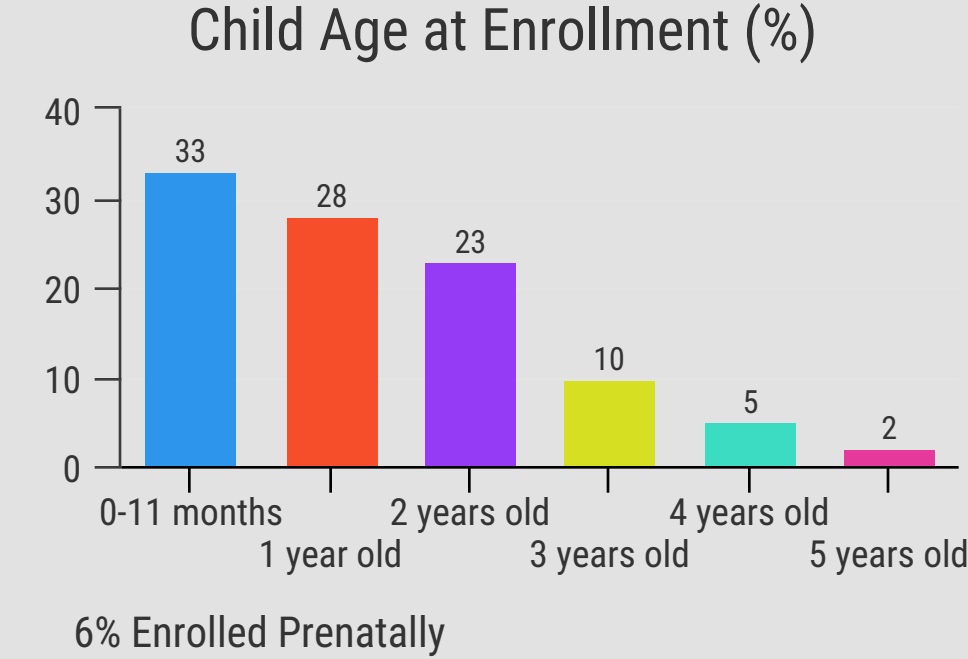
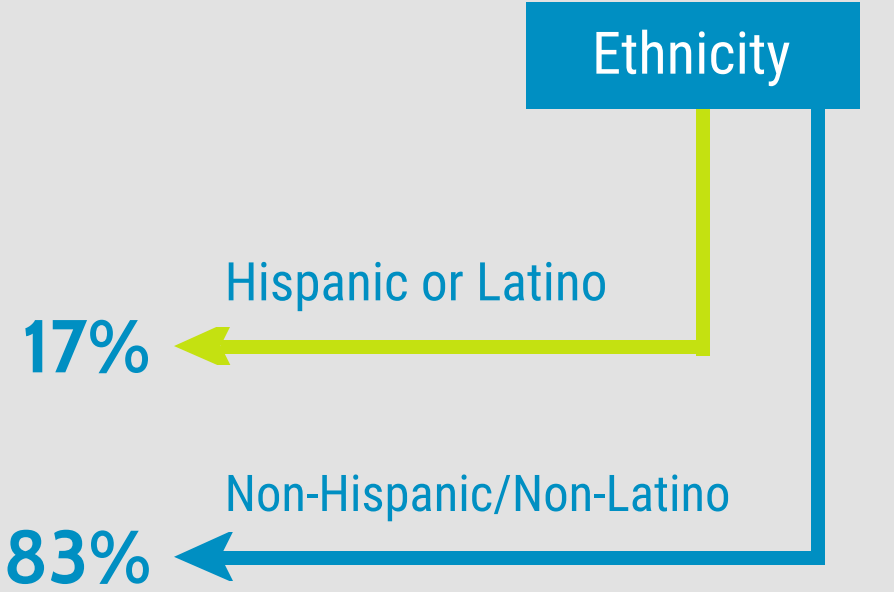
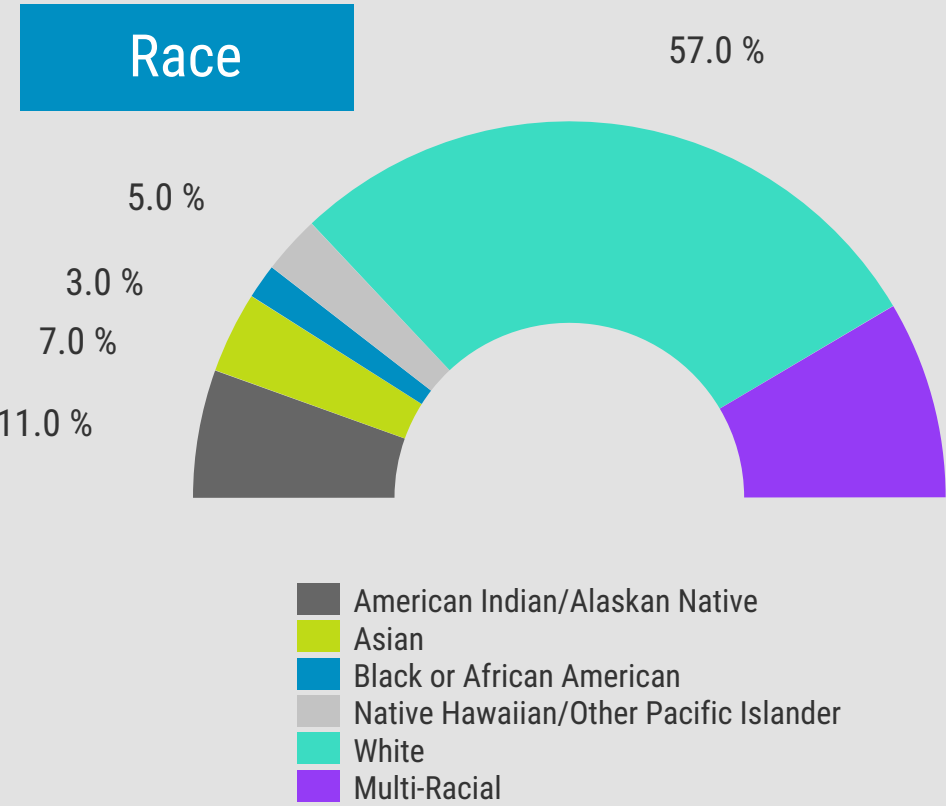
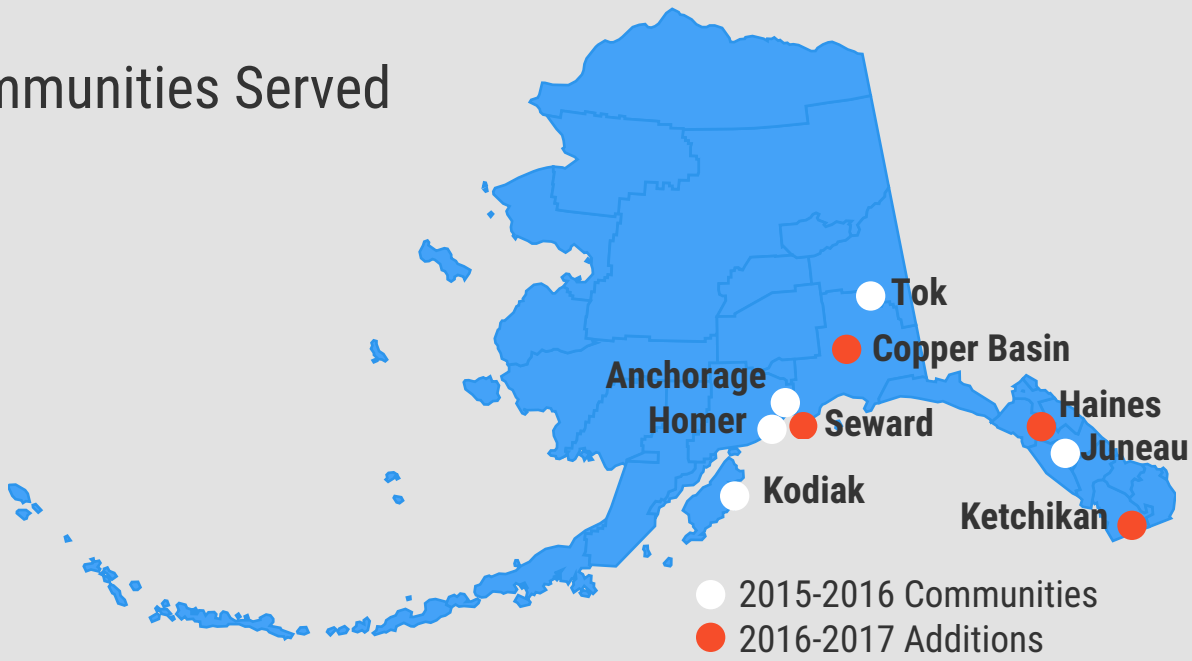
Parents as Teachers™

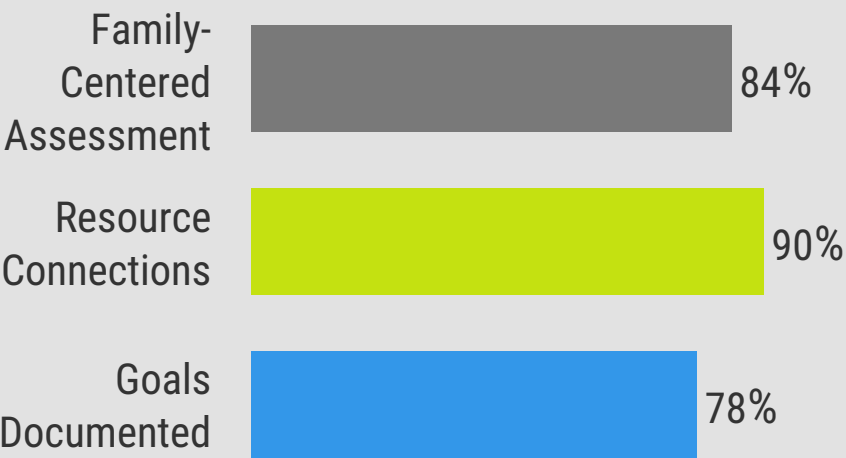

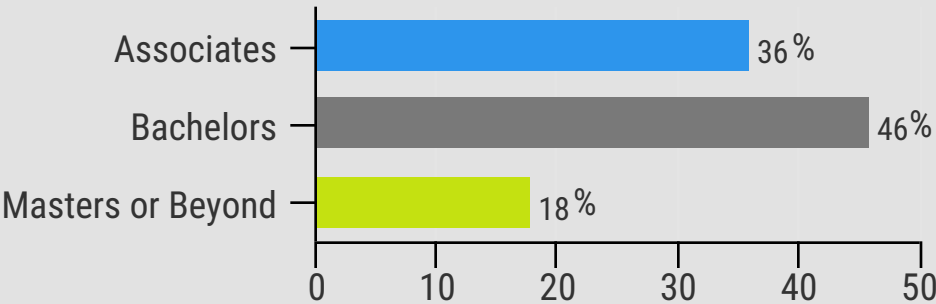

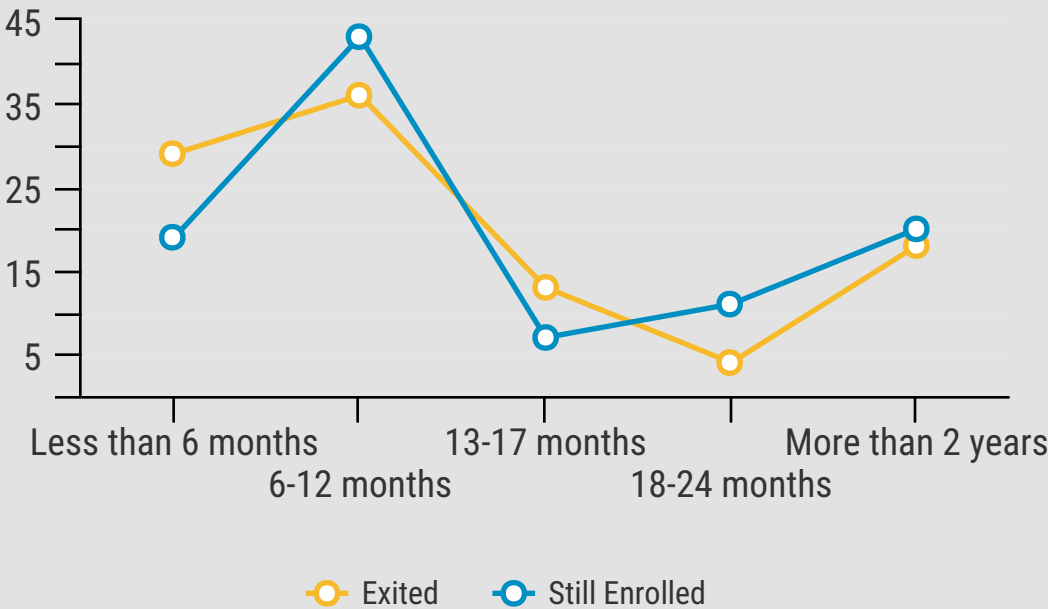
