A school district may not receive state education aid for K-12 support appropriated under Section 1 of this Act and distributed by the Department of Education and Early Development under AS 14.17 if the school district (1) has a policy refusing to allow recruiters for any branch of the United States Military, Reserve Officers' Training Corps, Central Intelligence Agency or Federal Bureau of Investigation to contact students on a school campus if the school district allows college, vocational school, or other job recruiters on campus to contact students; (2) refuses to allow the Boy Scouts of America to use school facilities for meetings or contract with students if the school makes the facility available to other non- school groups in the community; or (2) has a policy of refusing to have an in-school Reserve Officers' Training program or a Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps program.

S DOE 8 - Replace UGF in Mt. Edgecumbe Boarding School with PSTF (Other) Offered by Senator Dunleavy This amendment appropriates \$4,758.8 of available balance in the interest account of the Public School Trust Fund, beyond the \$20,000.0 present in the DEED budget under the foundation formula. This amendment replaces UGF in the Mt. Edgecumbe Boarding School appropriation with PSTF. AS 37.14.140 (Utilization of PSTF Income) states: "The net income of the fund may not be appropriated for a purpose other than the support of the state public school program." According to the MEHS budget RDU, this public school provides education "in a residential setting for students from more than 100 Alaska communities." According to MEHS: "The central role of Mt. Edgecumbe High School in Alaskan education is to provide a broad range of academic and extra-curricular opportunities that are unavailable to students in isolated home schools and communities [emphasis added]... the official governing body charged with oversight is the Alaska State Board of Education." It is the contention of this amendment that Mt. A separate amendment will reinsert this funding at the same level, as a one-time increment (IncOTI), requiring the department to return to the legislature next year for a further request.
