## **Analysis**

Section 17 adds new subsection AS 47.14.112, Training and workload standards; report to legislature, to implement workload standards and training programs for the Office of Children's Services front line case carrying staff. The amendment recommends a longer training period of a minimun of six weeks.  The Department's current training occurs over a period of three weeks. The Department maintains a contract with the University of Alaska Anchorage, Child Welfare Academy, in the amount of \$917.5 for the existing three week training. An		
additional \$784.2 would be required to extend the training for front line case carrying staff to six weeks.
