STATE OF ALASKA 2017 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This bill authorizes the Department of Public Safety to enter into agreements with federal, tribal, local government or nonprofit regional corporations to provide law enforcement services in areas that would otherwise be left without coverage due to budget cuts. The Department of Public Safety is authorized to collect fees for services provided with an effective date of July 1, 2017. The Shared Services of Alaska, Purchasing component anticipates no impact as a result of adopting this language.
