

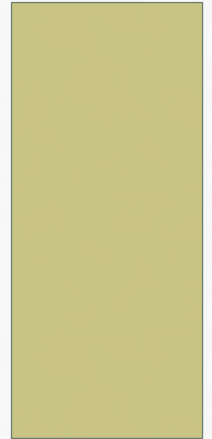

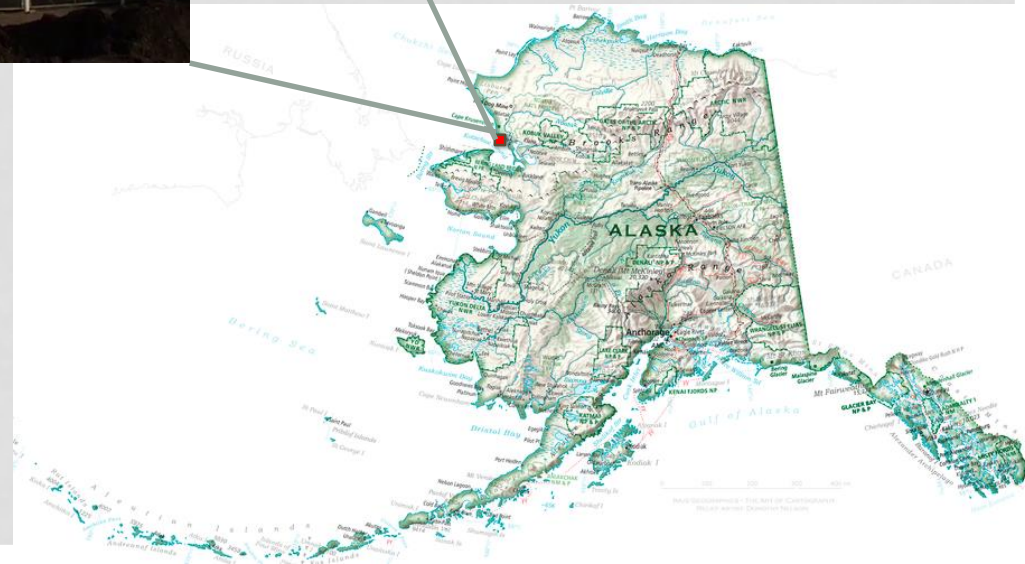

WHAT IS NEEDED

Summary of the E-Rate Modernization Order

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) adopted the *E-rate Modernization Order* on July 11, 2014

Internet Access (Order ¶¶ 34-38)

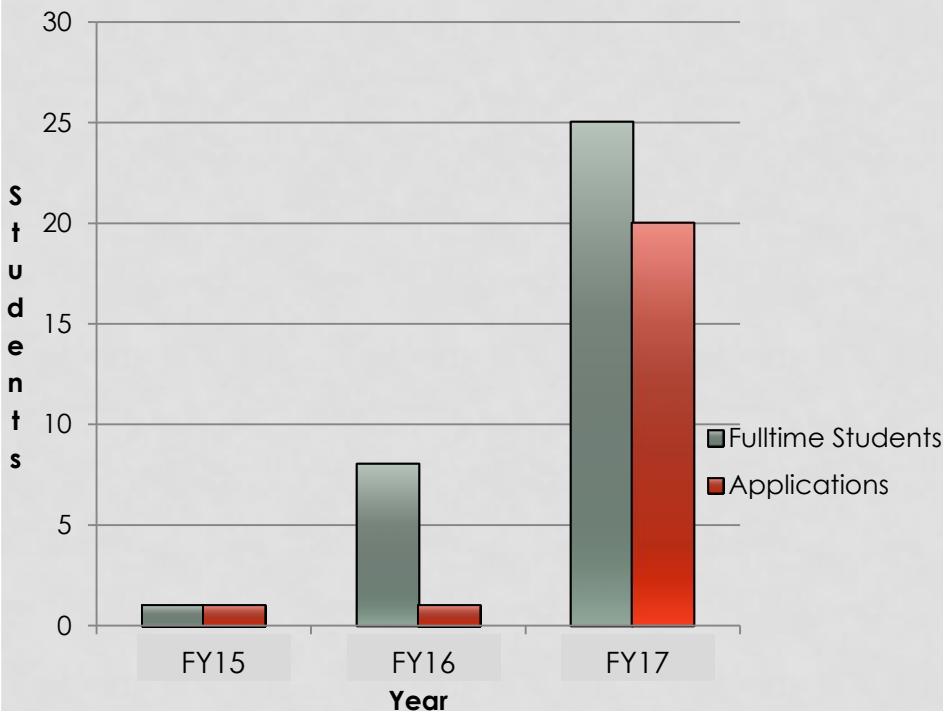
The Order adopts, as bandwidth targets, the State Education Technology Directors Association's (SETDA) recommendation for Internet access for schools of **at least 100 Mbps per 1,000 students and staff (users) in the short term** and 1 Gbps Internet access per 1,000 users in the longer term.

- This 2014 short term goal equates to 100Kbps per User.
- NWABSD currently provides 69 Kbps per User.
- \$164,000 per month is needed to bring NWABSD up to the FCC 2014 short term goal.

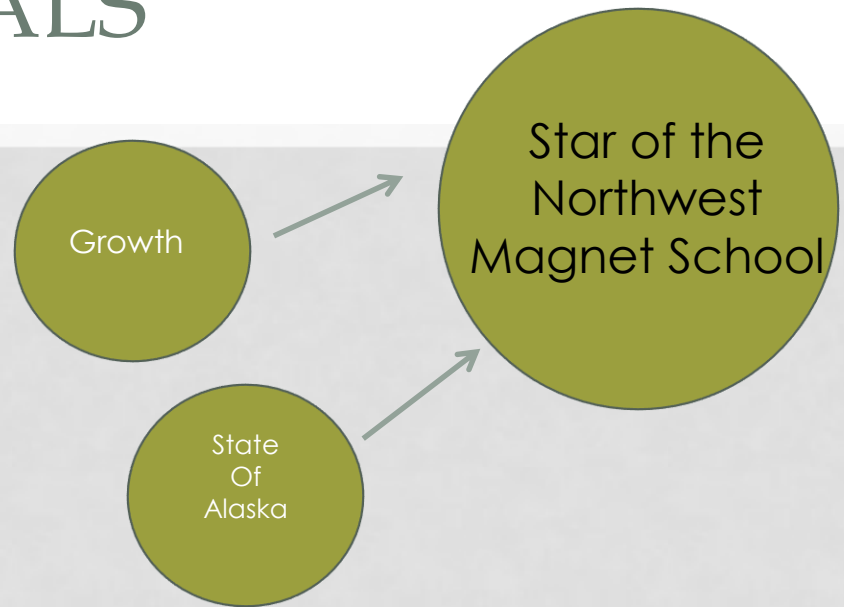
